Join us for our Ash Wednesday Service on March 5 at 7:00 PM. This service signifies a season of fasting, praying, and acknowledging our deep need for Jesus. We remember Jesus' forty-day fast in the wilderness, so we also enter a journey of fasting in the wilderness for forty days. Too often we rush to Easter focusing on eggs, chocolate, and bunnies, but really, this is about drawing closer to Christ so that we can emerge with more humility than when we began.

On Palm Sunday, we will be taking in new members, and on Easter Sunday, we will be celebrating baptisms. Any information regarding these two important practices can be found in the newsletter, or you can contact the Church Office. There will be classes offered for both so that you can understand more about church membership and believers' baptism. They are both offered at the 9 o'clock hour over some upcoming Sundays.

My prayer for you and your family this season is that you will stop and focus on the significance of the Season of Lent.
